This weekend is an eligible weekend for NCAA D II , D III, and NAIA Schools to be in attendance. Schools representing all 3 of these levels, both boys and girls, will be watching games throughout the weekend. This time period is a Dead Period for NCAA Division I institutions to view players. So play your best!!

We will use 4 different facilities for this tournament: John Carroll University, Gilmour Academy, The Pinnacle Edge, and Independence Field House. Addresses and directions can be found on the tournament website.

**Registration will be set up at John Carroll University from 2:00pm until 9:30pm ON FRIDAY. Registration will also be from 7:00am until 3:00pm Saturday at JCU. You must register your team and pick up your team packet prior to your first game!!!**

**Also please note: The skills competition is scheduled for Saturday night June 25<sup>th</sup> from 7:30-9:30pm. All participants must be in John Carroll's main gym by 7pm. There will also be free refreshments and various other surprises for spectators during the competition.**

**Every team must provide 1 table helper per game. This person will be a scoreboard timer or scorekeeper for the game.** Tournament t-shirts will be sold in the concession areas at all facilities for \$10 apiece.
